



Modern Slavery Statement

As an SME trading below the threshold we are not required to make a formal Modern Slavery Statement. However, we do recognise that many of our clients will be seeking reassurance from us about our compliance with the requirements of the Modern Slavery Act.

Our modern slavery and human trafficking statement

Modern slavery is a crime and a violation of fundamental human rights. It takes various forms, such as slavery, servitude, forced and compulsory labour and human trafficking, all of which have in common the deprivation of a person's liberty by another in order to exploit them for personal or commercial gain.

Organisational structure

We are a provider of products and services to organisations globally and we source finished goods from domestic and international suppliers. We have conducted a risk assessment of these suppliers and determined that there are relatively few risks in our supply chains or within our business. As part of our initiative to identify and mitigate risk, we have conducted a risk assessment and will review this on an annual basis. Global is also a member of SEDEX (details on request).

Responsibilities

We have agreed that one of our Directors, Alex Clarkson, will have lead responsibility for our work in this area and will provide training on the requirements of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 to all our independent contractors. This will include outlining to our contractors how they can raise any concerns about potential violations of our code of ethics or if there are concerns about any of our clients being involved in activities which are contrary to the spirit and intentions of the modern Slavery Act.
